## Special instructions/comments regarding participant's arrival:

Participants should fly into either O'Hare International Airport or Midway International Airport, both in Chicago, Illinois.

The employer might pick-up participants from the airport, however, participants MUST contact the employer with their arrival details at least ONE week prior to their arrival to the U.S. Contact Madalina on WhatssApp at 630-999-0655. Airport pick-up is not guaranteed without first making arrangements with the employer. Participants can check into the housing at any time of day.

Participants may take their own transportation to the provided housing. Participants may take a taxi from the airport, which is located outside of baggage claim. The cost can range from \$30-\$60 depending on the time of day. Participants may also take public transportation, like the train and the bus, to the provided housing. If participants take this route, it is advised that they fly into O'Hare International Airport as it is closer to housing.

O'Hare International Aiport - (total travel time 1 hour and half)

STEP ONE: Participants should follow the signs to the CTA blue line. Cost is \$5.

STEP TWO: Once on the train participants will need to get off at the stop called Rosemont. STEP THREE: Participants will need to switch to the bus and walk 1 min to Bus 606 - Woodfield Coportate Center. The cost for the bus is \$2.25. They will ride on this bus for about 20-40 minutes. Please be advised that the 606 bus stops service at 3:30PM and does not operate on Sundays. STEP FOUR: Participants will need to switch to another bus at stop Woodfield Road and Mall Drive. They will then get on Bus 554 - Elgin Transportation Center. The cost for the bus is \$2.25. They will ride on this bus for 10-20 minutes.

STEP FIVE: Participants need to get off at the bus stop Golf Road and Salem Drive. From there they will walk about 10 minutes (0.3 miles) to their housing.

Participants whose employment is terminated (involuntarily or voluntarily) have 2 weeks from the last day of work to find a new job and to submit a valid and complete Self-Arranged Job Offer (SAJO) to Greenheart Exchange for consideration. If the participant fails to submit a SAJO within the two-week deadline, Greenheart Exchange will shorten the participant's program.

If Greenheart Exchange rejects the SAJO, the participant has one (1) business day to resubmit a new or a revised SAJO, based on the directions received from Greenheart Exchange.
