Arnolds Park is a tourist area with many entertainment venues for visitors to enjoy. Experience the oldest amusement park west of the Mississippi, several golf courses, a full-service marina and rentals of boats, personal watercraft, wakeboards, scooters and bicycles. A diverse variety of restaurants, lounges and nightlife abound, including the Roof Garden. Numerous shops are clustered in several venues and are scattered up and down US Hwy. 71. Visitors have a wide range of accommodation types to choose from, including resorts, a time-share and public and private campgrounds.

Arnolds Park changes with the seasons. In the winter, there is a casual, informal atmosphere and in the summer the town is full of activity. The eclectic people who live in the area believe it's the best of both worlds.
