Participants may decide to fly into Chicago, Illinois instead of Green Bay, Wisconsin and will need to find their own transportation to Door County, Wisconsin (see Bus instructions below), or at least to Green Bay, Wisconsin.

If participants decide to fly into Chicago, Illinois they can make their own way to Green Bay, Wisconsin by bus. Participants will need to take the public train system or a taxi from the Chicago, Illinois airport (ORD or MDW) to the Greyhound station.

To take the public train system from O'Hare International Airport (ORD) to the greyhound bus station, participants can take the Blue line train (accessible in the airport) to the CLINTON stop. Participants will need to get on the train that says to FOREST PARK. Participants will need to get off at the train stop that says CLINTON. From there the participants will walk 4 mins to the Greyhound bus station. The address of the bus station is 630 West Harrison Street, Chicago, IL 60607. Participants can also take a taxi from the airport to the bus station. The cost of the taxi is \$35-\$60 depending on the time of day.

The Greyhound Bus from Chicago, Illinois (Address: 630 W Harrison St, Chicago, IL 60607) to Green Bay, Wisconsin (Address: 901 University Ave, Green Bay, WI 54302) is about a 6–8-hour trip. Participants must take the Greyhound bus #5858 to Green Bay, Wisconsin. There are only 2 buses per day between Chicago, Illinois and Green Bay, Wisconsin. The first bus leaves at 6:15am and arrives around 11:00am. The second bus leaves at 5:00pm and arrives around 11:00pm.
