Instead of arriving at the airport in Myrtle Beach, participants may arrive at Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) in Atlanta, Georgia, which is located approximately 400 miles from Myrtle Beach. Upon arrival at the Atlanta airport, participants will have to arrange their own transportation to the Atlanta Bus Station in Atlanta and take a Greyhound bus to Myrtle Beach, SC.

From the Atlanta airport, participants can take a taxi or Uber or public transportation to the Atlanta Bus Station, located at 232 Forsyth St SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303. A taxi or Uber will cost approximately \$45. This price is only an estimate and is subject to change.

Participants may also take public transportation in Atlanta, by using the MARTA train. From the Atlanta airport, participants should take the Red or Gold Line train to Garnett Transit Station, and then walk to the Atlanta Bus Station. The one-way MARTA train ticket fare is \$2.50. PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

wear their uniforms at all times while at work. Hair must be clean and styled. Personal cleanliness is very important.
