Rental options range in price:

Participants should expect to sign a lease and ensure they carefully review the lease before signing it. In most cases, the security deposit is the same as the monthly rental fee.

Some landlords include utilities in their monthly rental fees and others will expect you to pay for utilities separately. Many landlords offer seasonal leases, as well as year round leases. Finding roommates or renting a room in an apartment, condo, or house can help lower your cost of living.

Participants whose employment is terminated (involuntarily or voluntarily) have 2 weeks from the last day of work to find a new job and to submit a valid and complete Self-Arranged Job Offer (SAJO) to Greenheart Exchange for consideration. If the participant fails to submit a SAJO within the two-week deadline, Greenheart Exchange will shorten the participant's program.

If Greenheart Exchange rejects the SAJO, the participant has one (1) business day to resubmit a new or a revised SAJO, based on the directions received from Greenheart Exchange. If the participant no longer has housing, the participant must look for permanent housing immediately, and within two weeks must secure permanent housing that complies with Greenheart Exchange's Housing Guidelines. The new housing address must be submitted to Greenheart Exchange within 24 hours of any change of address.
