Participants whose employment is terminated (involuntary or voluntarily), will have 1 week from the time that they end their position to secure permanent housing that complies with Greenheart Exchange's Housing Guidelines and submit a Self-Arranged Job Offer (SAJO) to Greenheart Exchange for consideration. Participants who end employment are required to move out of employer housing within 48 hours. If participants are not able to secure permanent housing and acceptable SAJO within 1 week deadline in the area, they have the option to end their programs or continue search for a new job and housing in different location for another week. Participants cannot be unemployed for longer than 2 weeks. Participant's failure to submit a SAJO within a two-week timeframe will result in shortening the participant's program sponsorship.

If Greenheart Exchange rejects SAJO, the participant has 1 business day to resubmit SAJO in accordance with instructions received from Greenheart Exchange. Failure to resubmit SAJO within 1 business day may result in shortening the participant's sponsorship. Rental options range in price:

Participants should expect to sign a lease and ensure they carefully review the lease before signing it. In most cases, the security deposit is the same as the monthly rental fee.

Some landlords include utilities in their monthly rental fees and others will expect you to pay for utilities separately. Many landlords offer seasonal leases, as well as year round leases. Finding roommates or renting a room an apartment, condo, or house can help lower your cost of living. There are safe and reliable housing options around the area. There is reliable transportation around the area and to the work site, both public transportation and Uber/Lyft options.
