January 29, 2025 Job Type: Lifeguard **Job Description:** Lifequards must constantly monitor quests in pools and surrounding area and ensure that quests follow the pool rules. Lifequards will be next to or in chlorinated water and will be in direct sunlight for long periods of time. Participants will be standing, sitting, and walking for long periods of time. Lifeguards must ensure a safe and healthy environment for the swimmers. Lifeguards must be able to recognize and react properly in emergency situations. Lifeguards must also check and maintain specific chemical levels in the pool and operate the pool filtration system. Lifequards will be handling chemicals. Additional required duties include, but are not limited to, cleaning the pool, surrounding area- deck, guard office, pump room, and restrooms. Job duties also include removing trash, enforcing facility rules, and gate control. If lifeguards work 6.5 hours or more at a multi-guard facility, they are required by law to take a 30 minute break, which is unpaid. **Great English Required** The hiring wage for ALL lifeguards is \$15. A very small number of participants may have the opportunity to work in Washington DC or Montgomery County, Maryland, but this should NOT be expected. The wage in Washington DC is \$17.50/hour and the wage in Montgomery County is \$17.15/hour. The vast majority of participants will not work in DC or Montgomery County, so they will not earn this higher wage. All participants MUST be able to work weekends! All Employees must be certified in Lifeguard Training, Community First Aid and CPR for Professional Rescuer. Lifeguard Training Class Requirements:

- *Swim 100 yards without stopping using front crawl (freestyle) and/or breaststroke.
- *Feet-first surface dive, retrieve a 10lb brick, bring it to the surface.
- *Tread water without using arms for 2 minutes.
- *Once this portion of the class is completed you move onto the remainder of the class, where First Aid, CPR, Rescue Techniques are taught. The duration of a class is 3 days. A blended version of online and in person training is offered in certain cases.

WPM will organize classes in various countries. Training must be completed prior to your arrival in USA if a class is scheduled in your home country. Lifeguard training fees will not be refunded in case of a visa denial.

If a class is cancelled students will be permitted to attend a class upon arrival in USA.

If WPM does not organize a class in your home country, you must pass Lifeguard Training upon arrival in USA. Prerequisittes may vary based on training availability. The fee for Lifeguard Training is \$250. All Lifeguard Training fees must be paid prior to attending a class.

Wi-Fi is available at the Library, at local cafes, and at coffee shops in our area. Wi-Fi is not provided in employee housing, however, participants may choose to purchase Wi-Fi services at their own expense.

Additional Comments:

PAYROLL:

Paychecks are issued on bi-weekly bases with two weeks processing time. It might take up to 4 weeks (one month) for participants to receive their first paycheck!

Final paychecks will be issued to participants on the regular pay schedule. If a participant does not collect their final paycheck before they depart the United States, they can arrange to have it sent by mail to their home address along with their housing deposit, which may take up to two months.

TRANSPORTATION:

All employees are responsible to arrive on time for their shift.

Job locations are within walking or biking distance from the housing with a few exceptions. Bikes are available for \$90

and up at Walmart or Target. A weekly metro pass is currently available for\$60.75 and a weekly bus pass is \$17.50. PHONES AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

The usage of personal cell phones, laptops, tablets, and other electronic devices is strictly prohibited while on duty. Overseas calls, long distance calls, and toll charges are forbidden at all Winkler Pool Management pools and housing. The fees for all unauthorized calls will be deducted from the employee's paycheck.

NO SMOKING:

Smoking is strictly prohibited in all employee housing. In addition to this, smoking is prohibited while on duty and in close proximity of work locations.

SUSPENSION:

Violation of company policies, such as using an electronic devices or smoking while on duty, may lead to suspension without pay or termination of employment.

LOCATION:

Winkler Pool Management Inc. manages pools in Washington DC, Maryland and Northern Virginia. The area in which international employees will live and work at is determined by the employer upon arrival and completion of training and orientation. The housing and work locations are within 80 miles of Washington DC. Housing and work placement location requests will be considered, but cannot be guaranteed.

Participants who would like to continue to receive housing from Winkler Pool Management after September 5 must contact Diyana Petrova at least 2 weeks in advance. Extended housing may be provided in a different location. Transportation Links:

FINAL CHECKS:

All checks issued after US departure will be held until the housing security deposit refund checks are issued and will be mailed overseas at the same time. Final checks can be sent by regular or registered mail. The fee for registered mail is \$20

If an employee's employment is terminated or the employee leaves the company, they will be immediately reported to Greenheart Exchange. In addition to this, the employee is responsible to cover all unpaid rent, training fees, and uniform costs. These fees will be collected from any unpaid wages. Winkler Pool Management is usually willing to negotiate the required move-out date for participants who are fired or quit. However, depending on the situation, participants may be required to move out within as little as 24 hours.

Participants will interact with Americans, both locals and tourists, at work and also as they explore the Washington D.C. Metropolitan area.

Participants whose employment is terminated (involuntarily or voluntarily) have 2 weeks from the last day of work to find a new job and to submit a valid and complete Self-Arranged Job Offer (SAJO) to Greenheart Exchange for consideration. If the participant fails to submit a SAJO within the two-week deadline, Greenheart Exchange will shorten the participant's program.

If Greenheart Exchange rejects the SAJO, the participant has one (1) business day to resubmit a new or a revised SAJO, based on the directions received from Greenheart Exchange. Information about prohibited jobs for SWT program participants can be found at https://greenheartexchange.org/host/host-hire-seasonal-staff/#/tab/regulations. If the participant no longer has housing, the participant must look for permanent housing immediately, and within two weeks must secure permanent housing that complies with Greenheart Exchange's Housing Guidelines. The new housing address must be submitted to Greenheart Exchange within 24 hours of any change of address. For additional cultural opportunities, Greenheart Exchange suggests that participants join the Greenheart Club at https://greenheartclub.org. Through the Greenheart Club participants can connect with each other, ask questions, find volunteer opportunities, take courses, and access resources.
